- Battled with the City over excessive noise and pollution from the COLPAI site.

- Helping to arrange the Imagine Golden Lane events.
- Had discussions with the City about rewriting leaseholder's leases to reflect changes on the Estate.
- Had discussions with the City about adjusting everyone's service charges to reflect changes on the Estate.
- Had a success with keeping the Estate Office in the base on Great Arthur House.
- Engaged with the City about major works such as the window replacement programme.
- With the Barbican Association write an open letter asking, in the light of new developments in the area, for a new overall plan for both Estates and the adjoining areas.

Issues for the next year will be the increased level of footfall over the Estate once Crossrail opens, anti-social behaviour, community cohesion as we emerge from the pandemic and anything else that comes up. We have recently been trying to focus on community events and community conversations. To keep this going we will apply for grants for social events.
