

Unwanted furniture or appliances for collection?

City residents can now donate items for re-use.

The City of London is working together with the London Re-use Network to provide a household collection service for bulky waste.

You can donate the following items:

- Furniture
- Washing machines and tumble dryers
- Electric cookers and Microwaves
- Fridges and Freezers
- Bikes

Ideally, items for re-use will be in good condition, free from rust and cracks and with their internal fixtures, but don't worry if a shelf or drawer is missing as these can probably be replaced.



Why Re-use?

- **It's environmentally friendly:** Re-use helps extend the life of an item. This dramatically reduces Co2 emissions, and minimises the need for raw materials.
- **Help provide training opportunities:** Re-use is helping to create volunteering and training opportunities across the capital. Helping out of work Londoners develop new skills and get back into work.
- **Support your Local Community:** Reusing furniture helps to provide high quality refurbished items at low cost. By donating your unwanted items you could support low income, recently re-housed families turn their house into a home.
