



Appointment of an external member to the City of London Police Committee

In its role as the police authority for the Square Mile, the City of London Corporation is responsible for ensuring that the City of London Police deliver a fair, efficient and effective police service. We are seeking to appoint an independent person to serve as a member of the Police Committee of the City of London Corporation to help it fulfil this role.

We are looking for someone who is able to:

- demonstrate a genuine, active interest in both local and national policing;
- provide independent oversight and scrutiny to deliver a fair, efficient and effective police service in the City of London;
- seek out and listen to the views of local communities;
- maintain a constructive partnership with the City of London Police and other relevant organisations;
- actively take part in meetings of the Police Committee and in any subcommittee, panel or forum to which you are appointed, as well as undertake preparatory work and attend appropriate training courses and seminars.

Force and authority meetings will demand up to 10 hours each month, but the level of further commitment will depend on you. Members of the Police Committee do not receive allowances, but you will be entitled to claim back travel and subsistence expenses and any loss of earnings as a result of your role. The appointment will be for a four-year term from May 2015.

You must be aged 18 or over and live or work in the City of London (Square Mile).
